- Most Americans believe Christmas celebrates a historical fact. In a [2021 Lifeway Research study](#), 7 in 10 U.S. adults (72%) said they believe the Jesus Christians believe in was born in Bethlehem more than 2,000 years ago. In an [additional study](#), 9 in 10 Americans said they celebrated Christmas, but only 22% said they could retell the Christmas story in the Bible accurately from memory.
- Entering into his fourth decade of leading The Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Dr. Mohler has seen generations of pastors and church leaders gain theological training and education. He also hosts two podcasts, serves as editor of *WORLD Opinions*, and regularly writes on faith and culture for leading newspapers.
