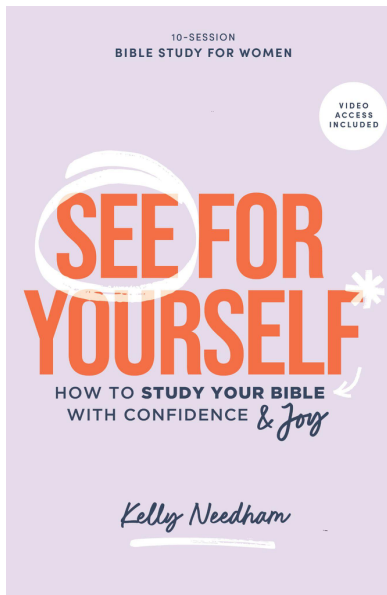


See For Yourself: A Transformative Bible Study

Authors Jimmy & Kelly Needham invite readers to encounter the living God through Scripture



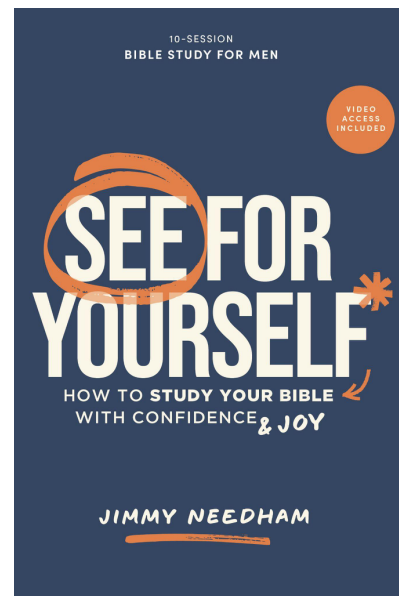
