

Kyle Worley’s ‘The Dragon Slayer and His Super Special Suit’ creatively shares gospel message

BRENTWOOD, Tenn., Jan. 30, 2026 — Inspired by the bedtime stories he tells his daughter, Kyle Worley has created a tale of bravery, hope, and a hero as a creative way introduce young readers to the gospel and the armor of God.

Pastor, author and Knowing Faith podcast host Kyle Worley’s latest release, “The Dragon Slayer and His Super Special Suit,” will release from B&H Kids, a division of B&H Publishing Group March 3.

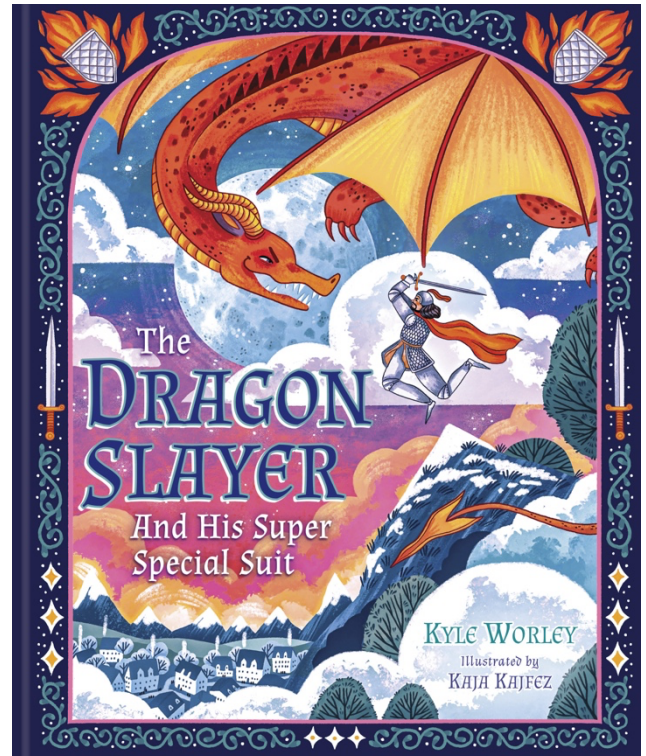
Worley’s narrative follows a town caught in the clutches of an evil, fiery-eyed dragon. On their own, the people are powerless—until a courageous dragon slayer arrives to defeat the dragon and equip the people with a ‘super special suit’ to help them stand strong until he returns.

The story mirrors the gospel message: the dragon slayer represents Jesus defeating Satan, and the super special suit represents the armor of God given to believers. The book encourages children to be brave and hopeful because of Jesus’ strength.

Possible Interview Questions

- This story originated in your story time with your daughter. Tell us more about how this book came to life.
- Why do you think the language of courage, good vs. evil, and a returning Hero resonates so strongly with young readers today?
- The “super special suit” points to the armor of God. How would you encourage parents to explain this metaphor to 4–8-year-olds in everyday moments—beyond just reading the story at bedtime?
- You’ve connected this story to helping children grasp what it means to be “in Christ.” How can parents use the book’s imagery to introduce union with Christ in simple, hopeful ways at home?
- How do you hope this book encourages parents in their efforts to share biblical truths with their kids?
- How would you suggest children’s pastors and volunteers use this book—story time, small-group object lessons, or take-home activities—especially alongside homeschool or church resources?
- The closing stanza points kids to fearless hope because “our Savior is strong.” How does that message speak to anxious or discouraged kids, and how can leaders and parents reinforce that hope throughout the week?
